

**DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY SLOW NO WAKE ZONE
ON LAKE MONONA**


Recent heavy rainfall has resulted in high water levels on Lake Monona. The high water levels pose a significant threat to shoreline erosion and damage to property on the lake.

Section 72.08(3)(a) of the Dane County Code of Ordinances authorizes the County Executive, with the approval of the Sheriff and the County Board Chair to declare all or any portion of the surface area of Lakes Mendota, Monona, Waubesa and Kegonsa as a slow-no-wake zone during periods of high water posing a threat to life or property. As of July 23, 2010 the level of Lake Monona poses a substantial risk to property and public safety.


The County of Dane hereby declares effective immediately, the entire surface area of Lake Monona to be a slow-no-wake zones. Slow-no-wake speed is defined as the minimum speed at which motorized watercraft is able to move and maintain steerage. This declaration will be rescinded as soon as it is determined that the water level has receded to a point that safe normal boating may be resumed.

Violation of the slow-no-wake restriction is subject to punishment by citation and forfeiture.
